## I. INTRODUCTION

- a. The County Treasurers' Association of Pennsylvania ("CTAP") is soliciting proposals from interested firms or individuals for the provision of membership association management service. The questions contained in this RFP will apply to all firms or individuals interested in responding with the intent of providing these services and will also frame the specifications that will be used to evaluate proposals. Please respond completely and concisely to all the information requests in the RFP in the order and format requested.
- b. Proposals must be received no later than 2:00 PM on April 3, 2026. One (1) electronic copy of each proposal is to be submitted. No hard copies will be accepted. The proposal must be delivered via email with a PDF file attachment to Alexander Glassman, Esq. at [aglassman@rudolphclarke.com](mailto:aglassman@rudolphclarke.com).
- c. CTAP will consider procuring membership association management services from a single firm for the period from hire through July 31, 2028. CTAP reserves the right, upon mutual agreement with the selected firm, to extend the agreement period for extensions of up to two (2) years. CTAP reserves the right to terminate the agreement with ninety (90) days written notice.
- d. CTAP has the right to consider proposals accepted after the above stated date and time. All proposals become the property of CTAP and will not be returned. All costs incurred by the respondents in the preparation and submission of a proposal shall be the sole responsibility of the respondent. Proposals and communication may be subject to the PA Right to Know Law except for proprietary information or other information protected by law.
- e. CTAP may select a proposal other than the lowest cost provider.
- f. CTAP reserves the right to cancel this RFP at any time and to reject any and all proposals submitted in response to this RFP, if CTAP determines such action or actions to be in the best interest of the membership. CTAP also reserves the right to request clarification of any submission, modify or alter the scope of services and solicit new submissions, reject any or all submissions either in whole or in part, and waive immaterial irregularities.
  - CTAP will post both the RFP and any subsequent Addenda to our website at <https://pacountytreasurers.org>. Proposers are responsible for ensuring they read any Addenda.
- g. Applicants may make inquiries for clarification of technical or administrative information related to this RFP to the designated contact. The deadline for such inquiries is March 13, 2026. The designated contact is:

## II. ABOUT CTAP

The County Treasurers' Association of Pennsylvania ("CTAP") was formed via state statute as a membership association for county treasurers throughout Pennsylvania. Pennsylvania has 67 counties.

*CTAP Mission: "To bring into closer association and cooperation the County Treasurers of the various counties, to secure more uniformity and cooperation in the conduct of their offices; to improve their services to the public; to discuss potential legislation with Senators, Representatives, other state Associations, or other governmental agencies; and for the general benefit and mutual welfare of the different County Treasurers' office and of the citizenry of the Commonwealth."*

*CTAP Vision: "The CTAP is committed to promoting excellence, professionalism and collaboration in the field of treasury management while safeguarding the financial interests of our communities."*

As of July 31, 2025, CTAP has over 60 paid county members. A list of all counties, their statutory fee, and whether they paid their membership 2022-2025 is included in Appendix A.

CTAP has no employees. The work of the organization is carried out through a combined effort of volunteers and the board. Currently both the Board Secretary and Board Treasurer receive annual stipends of \$6,700, paid quarterly. CTAP has a contracted Solicitor, Alex Glassman, of Clarke Gallagher Barbiero Amuso & Glassman Law. The board meets virtually every month for an hour-long meeting.

### In-person Convenings

Annual Conference: Each year the annual conference is held in a different region of the state (rotating: Northeast, Northwest, Southeast, Southwest) and one or two local treasurers volunteer to host with assistance from other treasurers in the region.

- Historically, conference organization has fallen heavily on the hosts and the CTAP Treasurer.
- The Conference is typically Tuesday 4pm – Friday mid-morning of the second week of June. The 2026 conference will be the third week of June, due to location availability.
- The Conference has an Executive Board meeting immediately preceding and immediately following, at the conference location.

Summer & Fall Seminars: Each April & October we host a one-day seminar, 8am-3pm in State College at the Penn Stater Hotel. The upcoming seminar will be held on April 22, 2026, from 8am to 3pm with a sponsored reception on April 21, 2026.

- The Executive Board meeting for dinner (5pm) and a meeting (6:30pm) the evening before at the hotel restaurant and then a meeting room. The Board stays overnight at the expense of the Association.
- The seminar day typically consists of several 30-minute or 60-minute sessions with representatives

from areas such as Dog Law, PA Hunt/Fish, financial institutions, etc.

- Lunch at the on-site restaurant is included.
- Historically CTAP has covered the cost of the seminar.
- Some Treasurers/Deputies optionally stay over at their own/County expense the night before.
- There has been some interest in looking at whether the Spring/Fall seminars should be longer and/or how to select the content.

We are looking for a firm that will provide services listed in Section III using their own staff members who specialize in certain functional areas. The provider should include the estimated hours and staffing. We expect a significant majority of that time spent in January-June, in preparation for and execution of the Summer Conference.

A 10-member Board of Directors leads the organization. The Board has the ultimate responsibility for all CTAP matters including the establishment of annual and long-term goals. The goals and related tasks are often assigned to the various standing committees designated in the CTAP Bylaws (Legislative (PSAECO) Committee and Dog-Law Committee). The Board has also had other committees such as

- Audit Committee
- Hunt/Fish and Boat Committee
- Pension/Finance Committee
- Small Games/Bingo Committee
- Hotel Tax Committee
- Nominating Committee
- Right to Know/County Code
- Tax Collection Committee
- Conference Committee

From time to time, the Board will also develop temporary ad-hoc committees to carry out a specific function (e.g., By-laws committee in 2023-2024). The volunteer effort of these committees is essential to CTAP delivering on its mission and vision.

Despite the financial and membership growth success, CTAP faces some challenges.

- We want to improve our educational offerings and formats to be more engaging, and accessible for members and their staff.
- We want to properly leverage sponsorship opportunities.
- We want to increase communications with all stakeholders, especially members and vendors/sponsors.
- We want to shift much of the annual logistics and conference planning from volunteer treasurers to the outsourced management. While there is still an interest for local treasurers to be involved in planning, certain segments would be moved to the management organization, including:
  - Vendor management and communications
  - Updates to websites
  - Communications
  - Layout and preparation of the materials, signs, etc.
  - Staffing during the event
  - Handling contracts
  - Handling and tracking registrations
- Volunteer hours have been key to the success of our organization so far, but we believe that with professional management support, our volunteers will better be able to focus on collaboration, advocacy, and education.
- The Board recognizes the need for long-term planning but needs help to grow beyond an annual focus.

- The Board also acknowledges it lacks the time and expertise to monitor and quickly respond to changing trends in membership organizations.

We hope to address these and other challenges as we move forward.

### III: SERVICES REQUIRED

Following is a list of services CTAP is generally seeking. However, CTAP is very open to considering alternative services and structures. Applicants are encouraged to propose additional services that are not listed below if, after understanding the organization, the Applicant believes CTAP would benefit from such services.

Applicants choosing to exclude any of the services listed below should clearly state so in their proposal along with a brief explanation of why the service has been excluded. A comprehensive list of all services will be incorporated into the resulting Agreement with the selected firm.

Any proposed services that will be performed by a subcontractor of the firm or individuals should be noted, and any additional fees that will be charged by the subcontractor must be disclosed.

- a. Association Management: Including, but not limited to, strategic planning, financial management, audit coordination, governance, document preparation, file management, board meeting coordination, general ops, etc.
- b. Conference & Seminar Management: Including, but not limited to, venue selection leadership and support, contract negotiations, speaker coordination, program development, onsite management, timeline development/tracking, exhibitor & sponsor management, registration, logistics, etc.
- c. Marketing: Including, but not limited to, monthly updates to members, social media engagement, website management, email communications, promotion of conference, etc.
- d. Membership Support Services: Including, but not limited to, regular maintenance of membership directory and database, renewal processing and management, recruitment and retention efforts, annual paper directories, etc.

All associated charges for these services must be illustrated in the completed fee schedule in Section VI.

#### IV. OVERVIEW OF RFP PROCESS

- a. CTAP will receive proposals from applicants through April 3, 2026 at 2:00pm. Proposals will not be opened or reviewed prior to the deadline.
- b. Proposals will be reviewed by a subcommittee comprised of members of the 2025-2026 CTAP Board of Directors. The evaluation will center upon the applicant's qualifications, experience, expertise, and fee schedule, among other considerations.
- c. The review committee may select up to three (3) finalists for interview. Interviews are expected to be scheduled for the last week of April and will take place virtually.
- d. After the interviews, a recommendation for selection shall be made by the review committee to the CTAP Board of Directors for approval.
- e. It is anticipated that the CTAP Board of Directors will make a final selection by May 15, 2026, subject to change.
- f. A formal start date will be determined mutually through discussion between CTAP and the selected firm or individual. As stated in Section I(c), the initial appointment is anticipated to run through July 31, 2028.
- g. Planning for the CTAP 2026 Annual Conference (June 16-19, 2026 in Coudersport, PA (Potter County)) is well underway under the lead of Potter County Treasurer Krista Miller. We anticipate the new vendor/individual will supply supplementary assistance in advance of the conference and in-person support during the conference, if feasible given the contracting timing.

## V: PROPOSAL QUESTIONS

The proposal must respond to each item below.

- a. Firm or Individual Qualifications and Experience:
  - a. If a proposing firm, briefly describe your firm, including the year it was founded, ownership structure, location, number of employees or subcontractors, and any affiliations with other companies or organizations.
  - b. If a proposing individual, please attach your resume or CV, including your location, and any expectations about working with subcontractors.
- b. Staffing: List the personnel you propose to assign to this relationship and their proposed responsibilities. [For applying individuals, this will be your individual information.]

Provide brief biographical information on each individual, including their positions in the firm, education, training, designations (if applicable), years & type of experience in association management, major clients and experience. Please highlight experience working with groups that may be similar to CTAP. Be sure to indicate which assigned team member will have primary responsibility of servicing this engagement.

- c. Similar Engagements with Other Membership Associations: List the five most similar engagements performed in the last five years that you feel are comparable to the engagement described in this RFP, and indicate the years covered by those engagements. For each of the five clients listed, provide the primary contact's name, contact information, and a link to their website, if applicable.
- d. Onboarding Approach: Explain how you or the firm will onboard CTAP to perform the required services.
- e. Ongoing Management Approach: Explain how you or the firm will manage CTAP moving forward. Use specific examples of how your firm manages membership associations.
- f. Work Samples: Provide samples of any work with another organization you feel would help demonstrate the value your firm can bring to CTAP. This can be an actual copy of work, a redacted copy, or a written explanation of something.
- g. Other Factors: Describe any factors that are relevant to your ability to successfully perform this engagement. What do you believe sets you apart from the competition, and what unique value-added services could your firm provide?
- h. Conflicts of Interest: Disclose all potential conflicts of interest, specifically any relationships with any member of the CTAP Board of Directors ([listed here](#) (typically there is also an Immediate Past President, but we are currently without)).
- i. Litigation: Within the last five (5) years has you or the firm, or an employee of the firm, been involved in any business litigation or other legal proceedings, including arbitrations, relating to your consulting activities?

If so, provide an explanation and indicate the current status or disposition.

- j. Insurance: What forms of insurance does the firm have against errors & omissions and/or fiduciary liability? The firm shall furnish CTAP with a copy of a certificate of insurance as evidence that this type of coverage is in place.
- k. Contact Person: Provide contact information in case it is necessary for CTAP to request clarification or additional information related to your proposal.

## VI: FEE PROPOSAL

Please provide your fee proposal, as well as the number of hours annually that your fee proposal includes. Primary fees should be based on the services described in Section III. If you would like to offer any additional services beyond those listed in Section III, please list the proposed fees and hours for those separately.

Your fee should assume an initial appointment as noted in Section IV(f) from June 1, 2026 through July 31, 2028 (this term may change through mutual agreement between CTAP and the selected applicant).

Separately, please also provide an optional fee reflecting services you might believe are necessary related to Section IV(g) with respect to 2026 conference planning. This would be in addition to the full appointment described in Section IV(f).

*Note: CTAP has very limited experience in reviewing fee proposals for association management services.*
